SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 196

October 21, 2015 - Offered by Senator VUKMIR.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

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3 20.165 (1) (hg) General program operations; medical examining board; *interstate medical licensure compact:* prescription drug monitoring program. 4 5 Biennially, the amounts in the schedule for the licensing, rule-making, and 6 regulatory functions of the medical examining board and the affiliated credentialing boards attached to the medical examining board, except for preparing, 7 8 administering, and grading examinations; for any costs associated with the interstate medical licensure compact under s. 448.980, including payment of 9 10 assessments under s. 448.980 (13) (a); and for the controlled substances board's 11 operation of the prescription drug monitoring program under s. 961.385. Ninety percent of all moneys received for issuing and renewing credentials under ch. 448 1213shall be credited to this appropriation. All moneys received from the interstate 14medical licensure compact commission under s. 448.980 shall be credited to this 15appropriation.".

This subsection does not apply with respect to an application filed with the medical examining board pursuant to the interstate medical licensure compact under s. 448.980 (5).".

The secretary of the board, on or before October 1 of each 3 odd-numbered year, shall mail or cause to be mailed to every person required to register a registration form. The board shall furnish to each person registered under 4 5 this section a certificate of registration, and the person shall display the registration 6 certificate conspicuously in the office at all times. No person may exercise the rights 7 or privileges conferred by any license or certificate granted by the board unless 8 currently registered as required under this subsection.".

Compact licenses shall be subject to additional fees and assessments, 16 as established by the department, the board, or the interstate medical licensure 17compact commission, to cover any costs incurred by the department or the board for 18 this state's participation in the interstate medical licensure compact under s. 19 448.980 and costs incurred by the interstate medical licensure compact commission 20 for its administration of the renewal process for the interstate medical licensure 21compact under s. 448.980.".
