**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1033**

March 22, 2018 - Offered by Representative Vos.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “enforcement” insert “and payment to persons charged  
3 with a serious crime”.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 1b.** 20.455 (5) (i) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 20.455 (5) (i) *Victim compensation, inmate payments.* All moneys received  
7 under s. ss. 303.06 (2) and (3) and 949.165 for the administration of subch. I of ch.  
8 949 and for crime victim compensation payments or services.”.

9 **3.** Page 1, line 6: after that line insert:

10 “**SECTION 2c.** 949.165 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is repealed.

11 **SECTION 2d.** 949.165 (4) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

12 949.165 (4) (a) 2. ~~Second~~ First priority for payments to satisfy money  
13 judgments under sub. (6).

1           **SECTION 2e.** 949.165 (4) (a) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

2           949.165 (4) (a) 3. ~~Third~~ Second priority for reimbursement, recoupment and  
3           restitution payments under sub. (7).

4           **SECTION 2f.** 949.165 (5) of the statutes is repealed.

5           **SECTION 2g.** 949.165 (6) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

6           949.165 (6) (title) ~~SECOND~~ FIRST PRIORITY PAYMENTS; SATISFACTION OF MONEY  
7           JUDGMENTS.

8           **SECTION 2h.** 949.165 (7) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

9           949.165 (7) (title) ~~THIRD~~ SECOND PRIORITY PAYMENTS; LEGAL FEES AND RESTITUTION.

10          **SECTION 2i.** 949.165 (8) (intro.) and (a) of the statutes are consolidated,  
11          renumbered 949.165 (8) and amended to read:

12          949.165 (8) PAYMENT TO ACCUSED OR CONVICTED PERSON. ~~If either of the following~~  
13          ~~conditions occur, the~~ The department shall pay all of the remaining moneys in an  
14          escrow account to the accused or convicted person: ~~(a) The~~ if the charges against the  
15          person are dismissed with prejudice or the person is found not guilty of the serious  
16          crime charged.

17          **SECTION 2j.** 949.165 (8) (b) of the statutes is repealed.

18          **SECTION 2k.** 949.165 (10m) of the statutes is created to read:

19          949.165 (10m) REMAINING FUNDS. If 3 years have elapsed from the date of the  
20          establishment of the escrow account and no civil actions seeking money judgments  
21          are pending against the defendant, the department shall transfer all remaining  
22          moneys to the appropriation under s. 20.455 (5) (i) for crime victim compensation.
