ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 396

October 27, 2017 - Offered by Representative Spiros.

AN ACT *to create* 947.06 (6) of the statutes; **relating to:** blocking a thoroughfare while participating in a riot and providing a criminal penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 947.06 (6) of the statutes is created to read:

947.06 **(6)** Whoever, as part of an assembly of at least 3 persons engaging in a public disturbance, blocks or obstructs the lawful use by any other person of any private or public thoroughfare, or blocks or obstructs any positions of access or exit to any private or public building or dwelling, and does any of the following is guilty of a Class H felony:

(a) Intentionally commits an act of violence that constitutes a clear and present danger of, or would result in, damage or injury to the property of any other person or to another person.

(b) Intentionally threatens to commit an act of violence that, if committed, would constitute a clear and present danger of, or would result in, damage or injury to the property of any other person or to another person, if the actor individually, or the assembly collectively, has the ability to immediately execute the threat.
