## 1 AN ACT to repeal 946.49 (1) (a) and (b); to renumber and amend 946.49 (1)

- 2 (intro.); *to amend* 946.49 (2); and *to create* 946.49 (3) of the statutes; **relating**
- 3 **to:** bail jumping and providing a penalty.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 946.49 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is renumbered 946.49 (1) and
5	amended to read:
6	946.49 (1) Whoever, having been released from custody under ch. 969,
7	intentionally fails <u>to appear as required or</u> to comply with <del>the terms <u>a</u> term</del> of his or
8	her bond that prohibits contact with another individual or prohibits his or her
9	presence in a specified location is: guilty of a Class B misdemeanor.
10	SECTION 2. 946.49 (1) (a) and (b) of the statutes are repealed.
11	<b>SECTION 3.</b> 946.49 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

6	(END)
5	once per underlying criminal charge for which he or she has been released on bond.
4	946.49 (3) A prosecutor may charge a person for a violation under sub. (1) only
3	<b>SECTION 4.</b> 946.49 (3) of the statutes is created to read:
2	guilty of a Class <del>I felony <u>B</u> misdemeanor</del> for failure to appear as provided.
1	946.49 (2) A witness for whom bail has been required under s. 969.01 (3) is
