**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 869**

February 20, 2020 – Offered by Representatives SWEARINGEN, LOUDENBECK and KUGLITSCH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 8: delete the material beginning with “and” and ending with
3 “park” on line 9.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 10: after “grounds;” insert “sales of alcohol beverages at the
5 state fair park;”.

6 **3.** Page 5, line 1: before that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 1c.** 125.06 (14) of the statutes is created to read:

8 125.06 (14) ALCOHOL BEVERAGE SALES AT STATE FAIR PARK. The retail sale of
9 alcohol beverages at the state fair park, by any person approved by the state fair park
10 board by resolution to make such sales, for consumption at the state fair park. The
11 state fair park board may not grant to a person approval under this subsection unless
12 the person meets the qualifications under s. 125.04 (5) (a) to (c).”.

1 **4.** Page 9, line 9: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
2 page 10, line 7.

3 **5.** Page 11, line 16: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
4 with page 12, line 2, and substitute:

5 “**SECTION 8g.** 125.29 (3) (j) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 125.29 (3) (j) The ownership, maintenance, or operation of places for the sale
7 of fermented malt beverages at the state fair park or on any county fairgrounds
8 located in this state. A brewer may not make retail sales of fermented malt beverages
9 at the state fair park unless the state fair park board has, by resolution, approved
10 the brewer to make such sales.

11 **SECTION 8m.** 125.295 (1) (i) of the statutes is amended to read:

12 125.295 (1) (i) Notwithstanding s. 125.33 (1), the ownership, maintenance, and
13 operation of places for the sale of fermented malt beverages at the state fair park or
14 on any county fairgrounds located in this state if the fermented malt beverages have
15 been manufactured by the brewpub. A brewpub may not make retail sales of
16 fermented malt beverages at the state fair park unless the state fair park board has,
17 by resolution, approved the brewpub to make such sales.”.

18 **6.** Page 13, line 21: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
19 with page 15, line 6.

20 **7.** Page 17, line 9: after “125.29” insert “if the brewery premises or the brewer’s
21 off-site retail outlet is located in a southeast Wisconsin municipality”.

22 **8.** Page 17, line 10: after that line insert:

23 “3. “Southeast Wisconsin municipality” means a municipality any part of which
24 is located within Kenosha, Racine, Walworth, Rock, Milwaukee, Waukesha,

1 Jefferson, Dane, Ozaukee, Washington, Dodge, Columbia, Sheboygan, or Fond du
2 Lac County.”.

3 **9.** Page 17, line 11: on lines 11 and 21, delete “but subject to subd. 3.”.

4 **10.** Page 17, line 12: delete “Class “B” licensed premises” and substitute
5 “premises operating under a Class “B” license issued by a southeast Wisconsin
6 municipality”.

7 **11.** Page 17, line 13: on lines 13 and 23, after “license” insert “has adopted a
8 resolution allowing extended closing hours within the municipality and”.

9 **12.** Page 17, line 15: delete “A municipality may” and substitute “If a
10 southeast Wisconsin municipality has adopted a resolution under subd. 1., the
11 municipality shall”.

12 **13.** Page 17, line 18: delete lines 18 to 20.

13 **14.** Page 17, line 22: delete ““Class B” or “Class C” licensed premises” and
14 substitute “premises operating under a “Class B” or “Class C” license issued by a
15 southeast Wisconsin municipality”.

16 **15.** Page 18, line 1: delete “A municipality may” and substitute “If a southeast
17 Wisconsin municipality has adopted a resolution under subd. 1., the municipality
18 shall”.

19 **16.** Page 18, line 4: delete lines 4 to 6.

20 **17.** Page 18, line 12: on lines 12 and 13, before “municipality” insert
21 “southeast Wisconsin”.
