SENATE AMENDMENT 2, TO SENATE BILL 284

June 21, 2019 - Offered by Senator Petrowski.

- At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 2, line 3: after "competent" insert "and responsible".
 - **2.** Page 2, line 19: delete "the paragraph" and substitute "this paragraph".
 - **3.** Page 2, line 20: after "competent" insert "and responsible".
 - 4. Page 3, line 1: delete lines 1 and 2 and substitute "affect public safety or project cost or project schedule, the department may file with the joint committee on finance a request to authorize awarding the contract to the sole bidder. If the cochairpersons of the joint committee on finance do not notify the department within 14 working days after the date on which the department submits the request that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the request, the department may award the contract. If, within 14 working days after the date on which the department submits the request, the cochairpersons of the joint committee on finance notify the department that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the

purpose of reviewing the request, the department may award the contract only as approved, or modified and approved, by the committee. The department shall submit to the joint committee on finance quarterly reports listing any bids rejected or contracts awarded under this paragraph. This paragraph does not apply to a contract under s. 84.07 (1b).".

5. Page 3, line 2: after that line insert:

"Section 2c. 84.06 (2) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

84.06 (2) (d) The department shall review, update, and document its estimates of the reasonable value of the work for an improvement within 2 weeks before the date on which bids for that improvement must be submitted to the department.

Section 2e. 84.06 (2) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

84.06 (2) (e) In determining whether a bid exceeds the estimated reasonable value of the work, the department shall consider any addendums affecting the value of the work for an improvement that were issued before the date on which bids for that improvement must be submitted to the department.".
