**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 41**

January 28, 2022 – Offered by Representative PLUMER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 10 and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 2d.** 20.505 (1) (kt) of the statutes is created to read:

4 20.505 (1) (kt) *Opioid and methamphetamine data system.* All moneys received
5 from other state agencies and all moneys received by the department from the
6 department for implementation of the opioid and methamphetamine data system
7 under subch. III of ch. 153.”

8 **2.** Page 6, line 4: delete “heath” and substitute “health”.

9 **3.** Page 7, line 18: delete “2022” and substitute “2024”.

10 **4.** Page 7, line 21: after that line insert:

11 “**SECTION 4. Fiscal changes.**

12 (1) FUNDING INCREASE; TRANSFER FOR DATA SYSTEM. In the schedule under s.
13 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of safety and professional services

1 under s. 20.165 (1) (g), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2021-22 is increased by
2 \$1,500,000 to increase expenditure authority to accomodate a funding transfer for
3 opioid and methamphetamine data system.

4 (2) DATA SYSTEM FUNDING TRANSFER. In fiscal year 2021-22, there is transferred
5 from the appropriation account under s. 20.165 (1) (g) to the appropriation account
6 under s. 20.505 (1) (kt) \$1,500,000.”
