Revisions to Rules Regarding the Information to be Included in an Electric Utility Construction Application 1-AC-216

Clearinghouse Rule 07-044

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ADOPTING FINAL RULES

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin adopts an amended final rule relating to revisions to rules as a result of 2003 Wisconsin Act 89.

On November 19, 2007, the Commission sent a Final Order Adopting Rules to both houses of the legislature. On January 2, 2008, the Assembly Energy and Utilities Committee requested a meeting with the Commission about the rule. As a result, on February 21, 2008, the Commission submitted to the Committee the following changes to the rules:

PSC 111.71 Notification of additional work areas.

After the commission has issued a CPCN under s. 196.491, Stats., the applicant shall, before establishing any construction area lay down area, staging area or access route that were was not identified and described in the project application, notify the commission of the location of the construction area lay down area, staging area or access route, and demonstrate that the use of the construction area lay down area, staging area or access road route will not affect any threatened or endangered species, historic resources, wetlands, waterways or other sensitive resources. A construction area includes a staging area for receiving and storing materials and equipment required for construction.

PSC 112.073 Notification of additional work areas.

After the commission has issued an authorization under s. 196.49, Stats., the applicant shall, before establishing any construction area lay down area, staging area or access route that were was not identified and described in the project application, notify the commission of the location of the construction area lay down area, staging area or access route, and demonstrate that the use of the construction area lay down area, staging area or access road route will not affect any threatened or endangered species, historic resources, wetlands, waterways or other sensitive resources. A construction area includes a staging area for receiving and storing materials and equipment required for construction.

PSC 111.51(4) (b) 1. Within 10 days after a CPCN application has been filed, the commission shall send an electronic copy of the complete application to the clerk of each municipality and town in which the proposed facility is to be located and to the main public library in each county in which the proposed facility is to be located.

PSC 111.51(4) (b) 2. Within 10 As soon as is practicable, but no more than 30 days after the commission has determined that a CPCN application is complete, the commission shall send a paper copy of the complete application to the clerk of each municipality and town in which the proposed facility is to be located and to the main public library in each county in which the proposed facility is to be located.

Attached is an amended version of the text of the rule that includes the changes detailed above.
