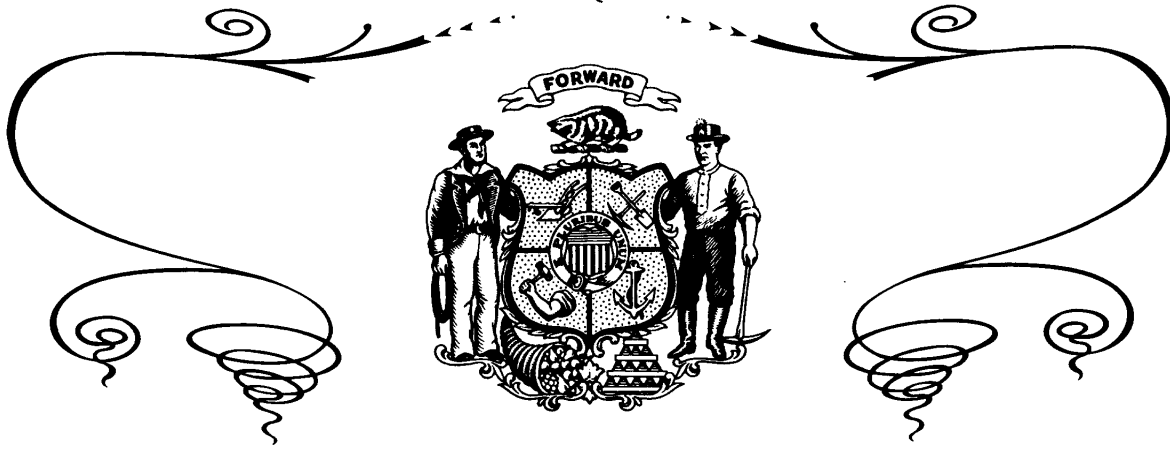


# State of Wisconsin
