

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2

WHEREAS, the Legislature, in Chapter 408, Laws of 1969, provided that under the general powers of the Executive Office, the governor may create and abolish non-statutory committees; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 408, Laws of 1969, provides that any nonstatutory committee shall expire on the 4th Monday of January of the year in which a new gubernatorial term of office begins unless the new governor, by executive order, provides for its continued existence;

WHEREAS, persons now serving on such committees remain members until they resign or until they are removed or replaced by action of the governor;

AND WHEREAS, I would like current members to continue to serve until such time as I have had an opportunity to review the membership and purposes of each such committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby recreate the following nonstatutory committees:
