ORDER BY THE GOVERNOR FOR SPECIAL ELECTION

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the Senate from the Sixth Senatorial District caused by the assumption of the office of Lieutenant Governor by Martin J. Schreiber, on the 4th day of January, A.D. 1971, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, A.D., 1973;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby order that a Special Election be held in the Sixth Senatorial District of the State of Wisconsin on the sixth day of April, A.D., 1971, to fill said vacancy, that the Special Primary be held to coincide with the Spring Primary on the second day of March, A.D., 1971, and that said Special Election and Special Primary shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
