EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 70

WHEREAS, travel on public highways in the State of Wisconsin is subject to imminent threat of blockage and disruption which may result in danger to motorists and interruption in the necessary flow of goods and commerce;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby declare a

STATE OF EMERGENCY

to exist in Wisconsin starting at 10:00 p.m., December 12, 1973, until the extreme danger to public welfare and safety on Wisconsin highways is abated.

FURTHER, under the authority contained in Section 21.11 of the Wisconsin Statutes, I hereby order into state service sufficient men and equipment of the Wisconsin National Guard as are necessary to assist the members of the Wisconsin State Traffic Patrol in the performance of their duties during this critical period.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison, this 12th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.
