

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 45

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative from the 32nd Assembly District because of the resignation of Peter J. Tropman, effective July 25, 1977, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARTIN J. SCHREIBER, Acting Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that, to fill said vacancy, a Special Election be held in the 32nd Assembly District in the State of Wisconsin, encompassing that part of Milwaukee County in the City of Milwaukee as more particularly described in Section 4.11 (2), Wis. Stats., on October 4, 1977. The circulation of nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on August 2, 1977. The deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates shall be 5:00 p.m., August 19, 1977. The Special Primary shall be held on September 6, 1977. The Special Election shall be held on October 4, 1977. Said Special Election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
