



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 28

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists within the meaning of Section 17.03(5), Wisconsin Statutes, in the office of the State Representative from the 53rd Assembly District, as a result of the vacation thereof, pursuant to Article XIII, Section 3 of the Wisconsin Constitution, by James R. Lewis whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the existing vacancy, be held on January 31, 1980, in the 53rd Assembly District, consisting of parts of Dodge, Fond du Lac and Washington Counties, as described in Section 4.18(2), Wisconsin Statutes.

AND, the circulation of nominating papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on November 26, 1979; the deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates shall be 5:00 P.M., December 13, 1979. The special primary shall be held on January 3, 1980. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with the law.
