

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 38

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 36, pertaining to the calling of a Special Election to fill the vacancy existing in the 33rd Senate District, contains an error in paragraph one relating to the date on which Roger P. Murphy's term of office would have expired; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that Executive Order No. 36 be amended for the purpose of correcting the date cited in paragraph one, written line number four, only;

NCW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby order that written line number four, paragraph one, of Executive Order No. 36 be stricken, and do amend and correct the date contained therein to read:

". . . expired on the first Monday in January, 1983, . . . "

AND, this Executive Order is issued for corrective purposes only and nothing contained herein shall affect or change the intent and purpose of Executive Order No. 36, issued March 1, 1980.
