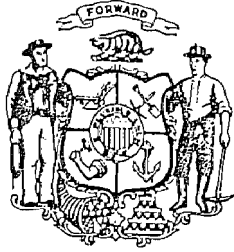

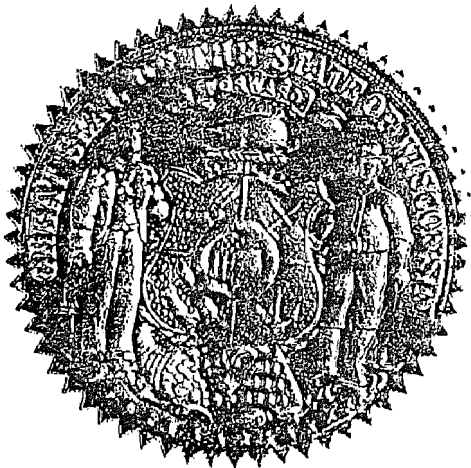
### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 88

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative from the 83rd Assembly District as a result of the resignation of John C. Shabaz, whose term would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1983;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election to fill the vacancy be held in the 83rd Assembly District, consisting of part of the County of Waukesha as described in Section 4.28(2), Wisconsin Statutes, said election to coincide with the Spring Election on April 6, 1982;

AND, the circulation of nominating papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on December 21, 1981; the deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates shall be 5:00 p.m., January 12, 1982. The special primary election shall coincide with the Spring Primary on February 16, 1982.


The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
