EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17(2)

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin recognizes the long and faithful service Brigadier General Hugh Simonson has given to the state and the nation; and

WHEREAS, upon the death of Brigadier General Hugh Simonson, he shall receive the honor of burial in the cemetery located at the foot of Long Bluff at Camp Williams Military Reservation, Camp Douglas, Wisconsin; and
