EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 21

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative from the 71st Assembly District, due to the election to the Senate of Representative David Helbach, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January of 1985;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority given me by Wis. Stats. s. 8.50, do order that a special election to fill the vacancy be held on November 1, 1983 in the 71st Assembly District, as described in the 1983 Wisconsin Act 29, which district includes portions of the counties of Portage and Waupaca.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the circulation of nomination papers for candidates may commence on the date of this order and said nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. September 6, 1983, and the primary, if one is necessary, shall be held on October 4, 1983. The election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.


