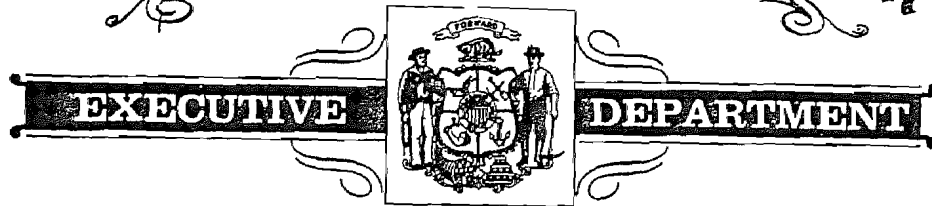


# The State of Wisconsin




## EXECUTIVE ORDER 40

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of municipal judge for the Village of Waterford due to the resignation of Judge Gregory Miller whose term of office would have expired on May 1, 1985;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 8.50 and 755.01(1), do order that a special election to fill the vacancy be held on April 3, 1984 and a special primary, if necessary, be held on February 21, 1984 in the Village of Waterford. Nomination papers may be circulated on and after the date of this order and must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 10, 1984. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
