

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 112

WHEREAS, heavy rains and flooding occurred in the State of Wisconsin on September 10 and 11, 1986, endangering the safety and well-being of the affected citizens of this state, causing hardship and suffering for them; and

WHEREAS, the counties of Fond du Lac, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, and Sheboygan have been especially affected by the severe weather;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority granted me by Wis. Stats. § 166.03 (b), declare a state of emergency exists in the counties of Fond du Lac, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, and Sheboygan, and direct the State Division of Emergency Government, and other appropriate state and local government agencies to take whatever actions are necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of the affected citizens and to alleviate their suffering and loss.
