

## EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 118

WHEREAS, State Senator Timothy Cullen was elected on November 4, 1986 to represent the Fifteenth Senate District for a term to begin January 5, 1987 and he has declined the office to which he was elected, creating a vacancy and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to extend the nomination paper filing deadline for the previously ordered special elections for the Second and 18th Senate Districts,

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. §8.50(4) order that a special election to fill the vacancy be held in the Fifteenth Senate District as described in Stats. §4.009(15), on April 7, 1987, coinciding with the spring election and that if a primary is necessary it be held on February 17, 1987, coinciding with the spring primary. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., January 13, 1987. The election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.

I further order that nomination papers for the previously ordered special elections for the Second and 18th Senate Districts may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., January 13, 1987 rather than the previously ordered January 6, 1987.
