EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 4

Relating to the Proclamation of a State of Emergency in Executive Order No. 3


WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was declared in Executive Order No. 3 for St. Croix, Pierce, Pepin, Buffalo, Trempealeau, LaCrosse, Vernon, Crawford and Grant counties in the State of Wisconsin due to flooding of varying degrees caused by extremely high water levels on the Mississippi River and its tributaries; and

WHEREAS, such severe flooding has occurred in several counties; and

WHEREAS, Crawford County officials have requested assistance from the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, and specifically by Sections 21.11 (1) and 166.03 (1)(b) 1 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

- 1. Proclaim that a State of Emergency continues to exist in St. Croix, Pierce, Pepin, Buffalo, Trempealeau, LaCrosse, Vernon, Crawford and Grant counties; and
- 2. Call to active duty such elements of the Wisconsin National Guard as may be necessary to respond to this natural disaster; and
- 3. Direct all agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist the affected counties in recovering from this natural disaster.
