

EXECUTIVE ORDER #206

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff Honoring Fallen Baton Rouge Law Enforcement Officers

WHEREAS, on Sunday, July 17, 2016, the city of Baton Rouge, Louisiana experienced a heinous attack against law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, three officers were slain and an additional three officers were wounded, one of whom continues to fight for his life, during an ambush at a Baton Rouge convenience store; and

WHEREAS, Baton Rouge City SWAT admirably took down the shooter, stabilized the situation, and prevented him from claiming the lives of potentially many more officers; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Wisconsin mourn the death of the fallen officers who put their lives and safety at risk to keep their communities safe;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning immediately and ending at sunset on Friday, July 22, 2016.
