EXECUTIVE ORDER #107

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Fire Inspector David Jerald Tomlinson of the Poynette-Dekorra Fire Department

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2020, Fire Inspector David Jerald Tomlinson, of Poynette, passed away after contracting COVID-19 in the line of duty;

WHEREAS, Fire Inspector David Jerald Tomlinson proudly served his community as a volunteer firefighter for 31 years, including the last several years serving as Fire Inspector;

WHEREAS, Fire Inspector David Jerald Tomlinson served his community in many ways, including working for the U.S. Postal Service for 32 years and as a fixture in local youth sports;

WHEREAS, Fire Inspector David Jerald Tomlinson was a loving husband, father, son, and brother, a doting grandfather, and a friend to the community;

WHEREAS, a private family service will be held on Friday, February 12, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Wisconsin are forever grateful for the service, selflessness, and sacrifice of Fire Inspector David Jerald Tomlinson of the Poynette-Dekorra Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning on **Friday, February 12, 2021**, and ending at sunset on that day.
