

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2003 Wisconsin Act 306 [2003 Assembly Bill 306]	Issuing Worthless Checks

Act 306 provides that whoever issues any single check or other order of payment of more than \$2,500 or whoever within a 90-day period issues more than one check or other order of payment amounting in the aggregate to more than \$2,500 which, at the time of issuance, the person intends will not be paid is guilty of a Class I felony. A Class I felony is punishable by a term of imprisonment and extended supervision not to exceed three years and six months and a fine not to exceed \$10,000. Prior law considered the aggregate amount of the checks the person had issued within a 15-day period instead of a 90-day period. Otherwise, the offense was identical.

Effective Date: Act 306 takes effect on May 7, 2004.
