## 2005 Wisconsin Act 144 [2005 Assembly Bill 133]

## Prohibition Against Crossing a Fire Hose

2005 Wisconsin Act 144 provides that no person, without the consent of the fire department official in command, may drive a vehicle over any unprotected hose of the fire department when the hose is laid down on any street or private driveway to be used at any training exercise, scene of an emergency, or alarm of an emergency.

**Prior law** prohibited crossing a fire hose when the hose is laid down to be used at any *fire or alarm of fire*.

Effective Date: Act 144 took effect on April 1, 2006.
