**Office of Lawyer Regulation
(Remedial Legislation)**

2005 Wisconsin Act 157, suggested as remedial legislation by the Director of State Courts, updates the statutes by referring to the current title of an agency of the Supreme Court that regulates the practices of attorneys. The former title “Board of Attorneys Professional Responsibility” is replaced by the new title “Office of Lawyer Regulation.”

Effective Date: The Act takes effect on April 5, 2006.
