

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

## 2005 Wisconsin Act 161 [2005 Senate Bill 557]

## Designation of Certain Boats and Associated Tackle and Equipment as Public Nuisances (Remedial Legislation)

**Prior law** in the state's fish and game laws, ch. 29, Stats., designates a number of types or uses of equipment, structures, and animals to be a public nuisance. This list of public nuisances included "any boat, together with its tackle and equipment."

2005 Wisconsin Act 161 clarifies that any boat, together with its tackle and equipment, is a public nuisance if it is used in violation of the fish and game laws.

2005 Senate Bill 557 was suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Natural Resources.
