

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 17 [2005 Senate Bill 261] Ratification of Collective Bargaining Agreement: Administrative Support

2005 Wisconsin Act 17 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, for the 2003-05 Biennium, covering employees in the administrative support collective bargaining unit. The administrative support unit consists of roughly 6,766 full-time equivalent positions and includes clerical assistants, criminal history records specialists, employment security specialists, financial specialists, legal assistants, medical program assistants, payroll and benefit specialists, tax representatives and assistants, transportation customer representatives, and others.

*Effective Date:* The general effective date for Wisconsin Act 17 is July 23, 2005. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 17 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the administrative support collective bargaining unit.
