

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 170 [2005 Assembly Bill 957]

Single Trip Permits for Movement of Oversize Mobile Homes, Manufactured Homes or Manufactured Buildings

Under *current law*, single trip permits for the movement of oversize mobile homes may be issued only by the Department of Transportation (DOT), regardless of the highways to be used (i.e., local officials may not issue these). Every such permit must designate the route to be used by the permittee. [s. 348.26 (4), Stats.]

2005 Wisconsin Act 170 revises this provision to add oversize manufactured homes and manufactured buildings. Under the Act:

- 1. Single trip permits for the movement of oversize mobile homes, manufactured homes as defined in s. 101.91 (2) (am), Stats., or manufactured buildings as defined in s. 101.71 (6), Stats., may be issued only by the DOT, regardless of the highways to be used.
- 2. Every such permit must designate the route to be used by the permittee.
- 3. No permit may be issued under this provision for operation of a vehicle combination exceeding 110 feet in overall length or for movement of a mobile home, manufactured home, or manufactured building exceeding 80 feet in length. This is a new restriction created in the Act.

Effective Date: Act 170 takes effect on July 1, 2006. The Act first applies to single trip permits issued on that date.
