

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 184 [2005 Assembly Bill 826] Leaving a Child in a Child Care Vehicle

2005 Wisconsin Act 184 provides that a person who is responsible for a child's welfare while the child is being transported in a child care vehicle may not leave the child unattended at any time from the time the child is placed in the care of that person to the time the child is placed in the care of another person responsible for the child's welfare. A person who violates this provision is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$10,000 and imprisonment not to exceed nine months, or both. If death is a consequence, the person is guilty of a Class G felony, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$25,000 and imprisonment not to exceed 10 years, or both.

Effective Date: Act 184 took effect on April 7, 2006.
