

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 224 [2005 Senate Bill 382]

Transportation of Certain Public School Pupils

Current statutes, with certain exceptions, require that a school district provide transportation to and from public school for all pupils who reside in the school district two miles or more from the nearest public school they are entitled to attend.

2005 Wisconsin Act 224 provides that if a pupil enrolled in the school district is living outside the school district as a result of a joint custody agreement, at the request of the pupil's parent or guardian, the school district must transport the pupil to and from an agreed-upon location within the school district.

Initial Applicability: 2005 Wisconsin Act 224 first applies to the transportation of pupils in the 2006-07 school year.
