

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 236 [2005 Assembly Bill 217]

**Rabies Vaccinations** 

2005 Wisconsin Act 236 amends the law that requires dog owners to have dogs vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at specified intervals.

The Act allows a veterinary technician to vaccinate a dog against rabies if the technician is working under the direct supervision of a veterinarian and if a veterinarian is physically present at the location where the vaccine is administered.

Effective Date: The Act takes effect on April 13, 2006.
