2005 Wisconsin Act 259 [2005 Senate Bill 602]

Development Zone Credits for Certain Insurers' License Fees

Under prior law, a business, including an insurer, may claim income and franchise tax credits for creating jobs or for the remediation of polluted or contaminated property (brownfield) in an area designated as a development zone by the Department of Commerce. Also under prior law, certain insurers pay license fees and are allowed to claim as a credit against those license fees the amount of their certified capital investments in certain companies, as qualified by the Department of Commerce.

2005 Wisconsin Act 259 provides that insurers who are subject to state license fees may claim as a credit against the amount of those license fees their expenses relating to creating jobs or remediating a brownfield in an area designated as a development zone.

Effective Date: The Act takes effect April 20, 2006.
