

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 300 [2005 Senate Bill 536]

Transitional Halfway House Building Authority

Prior to the enactment of 2005 Wisconsin Act 300, Wisconsin law appropriated \$1,295,500 for the purpose of constructing a transitional halfway house building for the placement of sexually violent offenders. In addition, the law created a committee to assist the state in determining the location of this facility. [See Secs. 971r and 9107 (1) (d) 1. of 2001 Wisconsin Act 16 and Sec. 7m of 2000 Wisconsin Act 187.]

Act 300 removes the appropriation and authority for the construction of a transitional halfway house building and repeals the provision creating the committee designed to assist the state in determining the location of this facility.

Effective Date: The Act takes effect on April 21, 2006.
