

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 303 [2005 Senate Bill 350]

Display of Political Signs in Condominiums

Under current law, no condominium bylaw or rule or provision in a condominium declaration or deed may prohibit a condominium unit owner from respectfully displaying the United States flag. A condominium bylaw or rule may regulate the size and location of flags and flagpoles.

Act 303 provides that no condominium bylaw or rule or provision in a condominium declaration or deed may prohibit a condominium unit owner from displaying, in his or her condominium, either of the following:

- A sign that supports or opposes a candidate for public office.
- A sign that supports or opposes a referendum question.

A condominium bylaw or rule may regulate the size and location of signs.

Effective Date: The Act took effect on April 21, 2006.
