

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 307 [2005 Assembly Bill 739]

"Class B" Liquor Licenses for Opera Houses and Performing Arts Theaters

Under current law, there is a quota on the number of "Class B" liquor licenses that a municipality may issue. Act 307 creates an exception to the quota if the license is issued for an opera house or theater for the performing arts operated by a nonprofit organization. A license so issued authorizes the retail sale of liquor only for consumption on the premises where sold and only in connection with ticketed performances.
