

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 317 [2005 Assembly Bill 450] Absolute Sobriety for Drivers Who are Under the Legal Drinking Age

2005 Wisconsin Act 317 increases the forfeiture for driving while under the legal drinking age (21 years) and having an alcohol concentration above 0.0 from \$10 to \$200. If, at the time of the violation, there is a passenger under 16 years of age in the vehicle, the forfeiture is increased from \$20 to \$400. In addition, the bill requires the Department of Transportation to assess four demerit points for such a conviction.

Effective Date: Act 317 takes effect on April 21, 2006.
