

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 367 [2005 Senate Bill 481]

Wisconsin Higher Education Grants

Currently, the Higher Education Aids Board awards Wisconsin higher education grants ("WHEG grants") to undergraduates enrolled at least half-time at nonprofit public institutions of higher education or tribally controlled colleges in the state. Currently, a WHEG grant may not exceed \$2,500 for any academic year.

Act 367 increases that maximum grant amount to \$3,000 for any academic year.

Initial Applicability: Wisconsin Act 367 first applies to WHEG grants awarded by the Higher Educational Aids Board for the 2006-07 academic year.
