## 2005 Wisconsin Act 374 [2005 Senate Bill 709]

## Ratification of Collective Bargaining Agreement: Teaching Assistants Association

2005 Wisconsin Act 374 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the University of Wisconsin Teaching Assistants Association, for the 2005-07 Biennium, covering employees in the teaching assistants association bargaining unit. The teaching assistants association bargaining unit consists of approximately 1,233 full-time equivalent positions and includes teaching assistants, program assistants, project assistants, and hourly graders and readers.

*Effective Date:* The general effective date of 2005 Wisconsin Act 374 is May 13, 2006. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 374 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the teaching assistants association bargaining unit.
