2005 Wisconsin Act 377 [2005 Senate Bill 703]

Ratification of Collective Bargaining Agreement: Administrative Support

2005 Wisconsin Act 377 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, for the 2005-07 Biennium, covering employees in the administrative support collective bargaining unit. The administrative support bargaining unit consists of approximately 6,211 full-time equivalent positions and includes clerical assistants, criminal history records specialists, employment security specialists, financial specialists, legal assistants, medical program assistants, payroll and benefit specialists, tax representatives and assistants, transportation customer representatives, and others.

Effective Date: The general effective date of 2005 Wisconsin Act 377 is May 13, 2006. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 377 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the administrative support collective bargaining unit.
