2005 Wisconsin Act 380 [2005 Senate Bill 706]

Ratification of Collective Bargaining Agreement: Technical

2005 Wisconsin Act 380 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, for the 2005-07 Biennium, covering employees in the technical collective bargaining unit. The technical bargaining unit consists of approximately 3,365 full-time equivalent positions and includes information systems technicians, forestry technicians, licensed practical nurses, nursing assistants, and resident care technicians.

Effective Date: The general effective date of 2005 Wisconsin Act 380 is May 13, 2006. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 380 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the technical collective bargaining unit.
