2005 Wisconsin Act 42 [2005 Assembly Bill 261]

Recording Child's Statement in Certain Court and Administrative Hearings

Under specified circumstances, current law permits a videotape of a child's testimony to be used in criminal proceedings, in probation, parole, or extended supervision revocation proceedings, and in juvenile fact-finding hearings. Act 42 substitutes reference to "audiovisual recording" for the references in current law to "videotaped recording." The substituted language covers any technology currently available or available in the future for audiovisual recordings.

Effective Date: Act 42 takes effect September 1, 2005.
