

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 424 [2005 Senate Bill 306]

Fritz E. Wolf Aviation Center at the Dane County Regional Airport

2005 Wisconsin Act 24 names the state aviation facilities at the Dane County Regional Airport in the City of Madison the "Fritz E. Wolf Aviation Center." Fritz E. Wolf served for 35 years in state service, first as an employee of the former state Aeronautics Commission beginning in 1946 and then from 1967 to 1981 as the first director of the Division and later the Bureau of Aeronautics in the Department of Transportation.

The Department of Administration, which manages state facilities that are not under the jurisdiction of another state agency, has informally named some facilities until otherwise provided by law. Currently, the state aviation facilities at the Dane County Regional Airport are not named in honor of any person.

Effective Date: Act 424 takes effect on June 3, 2006.
