

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2005 Wisconsin Act 474 [2005 Assembly Bill 1163]

**Corporate Shareholder Liability** 

*Current law* provides that a shareholder in a corporation organized under Wisconsin law may be held liable for any amount owed by the corporation to its employees for up to six months of work per employee. A shareholder's personal liability is limited to the value of the shares in the corporation that are owned by the shareholder.

2005 Wisconsin Act 474 eliminates these provisions of current law, thus eliminating all shareholder liability.
