## 2005 Wisconsin Act 69 [2005 Assembly Bill 501]

## Corrections on a Marriage Certificate

2005 Wisconsin Act 69 requires the State Registrar to prepare a new marriage certificate if a court determination changes information on the marriage certificate concerning the identity of a parent of a party to the marriage. On the new marriage certificate, the State Registrar must omit the changed information concerning the identity of a parent of a party to the marriage, enter the unchanged information from the original certificate, and enter any new information included in the court order concerning the identity of a parent of a party to the marriage. The State Registrar may not note that the certificate is amended.

Effective Date: The Act took effect on January 6, 2006.
