

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 165 [2007 Senate Bill 49]

Admission to State Parks and Trails for Certain Veterans

Wisconsin Act 165 provides for free admission to state parks and state trails for any vehicle, except a bus, occupied by a state resident who does one of the following:

- Produces evidence that he or she is a veteran and is receiving federal disability compensation benefits as individually unemployable under federal law or for disabilities that result in a disability rating of 70% or greater, as specified in federal law.
- Produces evidence that he or she was a member of the U.S. armed services and was held as a prisoner of war during a war period or while in service in a crisis zone. The terms "war period" and "service in a crisis zone" are defined in the statutes.
