

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2011 Wisconsin Act 187 [2011 Senate Bill 370]

Ozone-Depleting Refrigerants

The statutes impose limits on the sale and use of ozone-depleting refrigerants and impose certain requirements on the maintenance of air conditioning systems that contain ozone-depleting refrigerants. In addition, the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection (DATCP) is authorized to promulgate rules to apply the same limits and requirements on a substance used as a substitute for an ozone-depleting refrigerant.

2011 Wisconsin Act 187 specifies that the DATCP may not, by rule, prohibit the sale of a substitute for an ozone-depleting refrigerant in a container holding less than 15 pounds of the substitute or regulate an individual's noncommercial use of a substitute sold in such a container.
