

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2011 Wisconsin Act 286 [2011 Senate Bill 275]

Membership of the Milwaukee Area Technical College District Board

2011 Wisconsin Act 286 modifies the Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC) District Board membership to be constituted as follows:

- Five persons total representing employers: three representing employers with 15 or more employees; two representing employers with 100 or more employees; and at least two representing employers who are manufacturing businesses.
- One elected official.
- One school district administrator.
- Two additional members.

Under the Act, the county executive of Milwaukee County and the chairpersons of the Milwaukee, Ozaukee, and Washington County boards of supervisors constitute the appointment committee for the MATC board.

The Act provides that the current MATC board members would not serve out their existing terms, but rather each member would be replaced as soon as the appointment committee appoints a replacement. The Act authorizes the appointment committee to make new appointments for all current board positions following the effective date of the Act. The new appointments will expire on a staggered basis in 2014, 2015, and 2016.

Effective date: The Act takes effect on April 27, 2012.
