2011 Wisconsin Act 6 [January 2011 Special Session Senate Bill 10]

Wetlands in the Village of Ashwaubenon

2011 Wisconsin Act 6 exempts an activity affecting a wetland of less than three acres in size from the water quality standards applicable to wetlands and other laws administered by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) that relate to water quality and navigable waters if:

- The wetland is in the Village of Ashwaubenon.
- The site of the activity is part of a tax incremental district.
- The site of the activity is zoned for community business use.
- The person engaged in the activity has provided wetland mitigation at a ratio of at least 1.5 acres of wetland for each acre of wetland affected, through the purchase of in-state mitigation bank credits or by completing an alternative mitigation project approved by the DNR.
- The wetland is a nonfederal wetland.
- The site of the activity is located in the vicinity of a professional football stadium.
